Regional Disparities

EU funding must address the gap between developed and less-developed regions.

Areas lacking digital infrastructure and expertise should receive targeted aid.

BAS4ICT supports funding that strengthens regional innovation ecosystems, providing the infrastructure, skills, and support needed for economic and social integration.



Simplification of Funding Access

A major barrier to EU funding is the complexity of application processes and regulations. BAS4ICT calls for simpler processes so SMEs, local governments, and regional stakeholders can access funds easily. Clear guidelines, standardized criteria, and streamlined procedures will help direct funding where it's needed.


